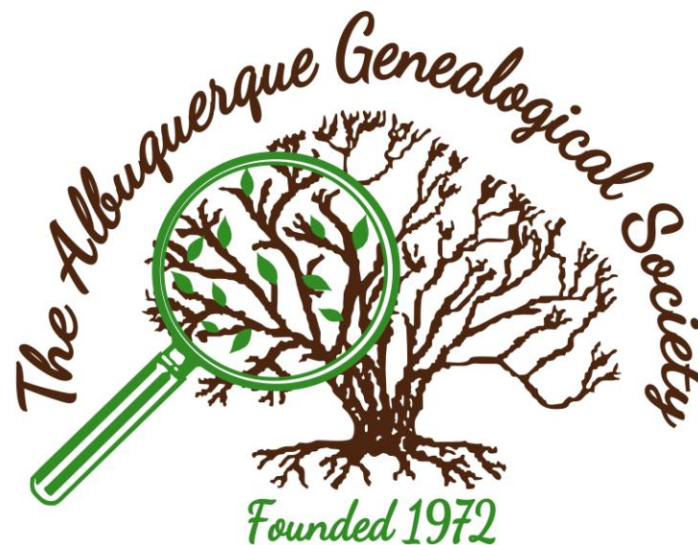
Please feel free to contact one of our officers or committee members for additional information. We hope that you will consider joining our society and sharing in our journey as we all seek to learn our family histories.
